— Yay-Sa-Doe —

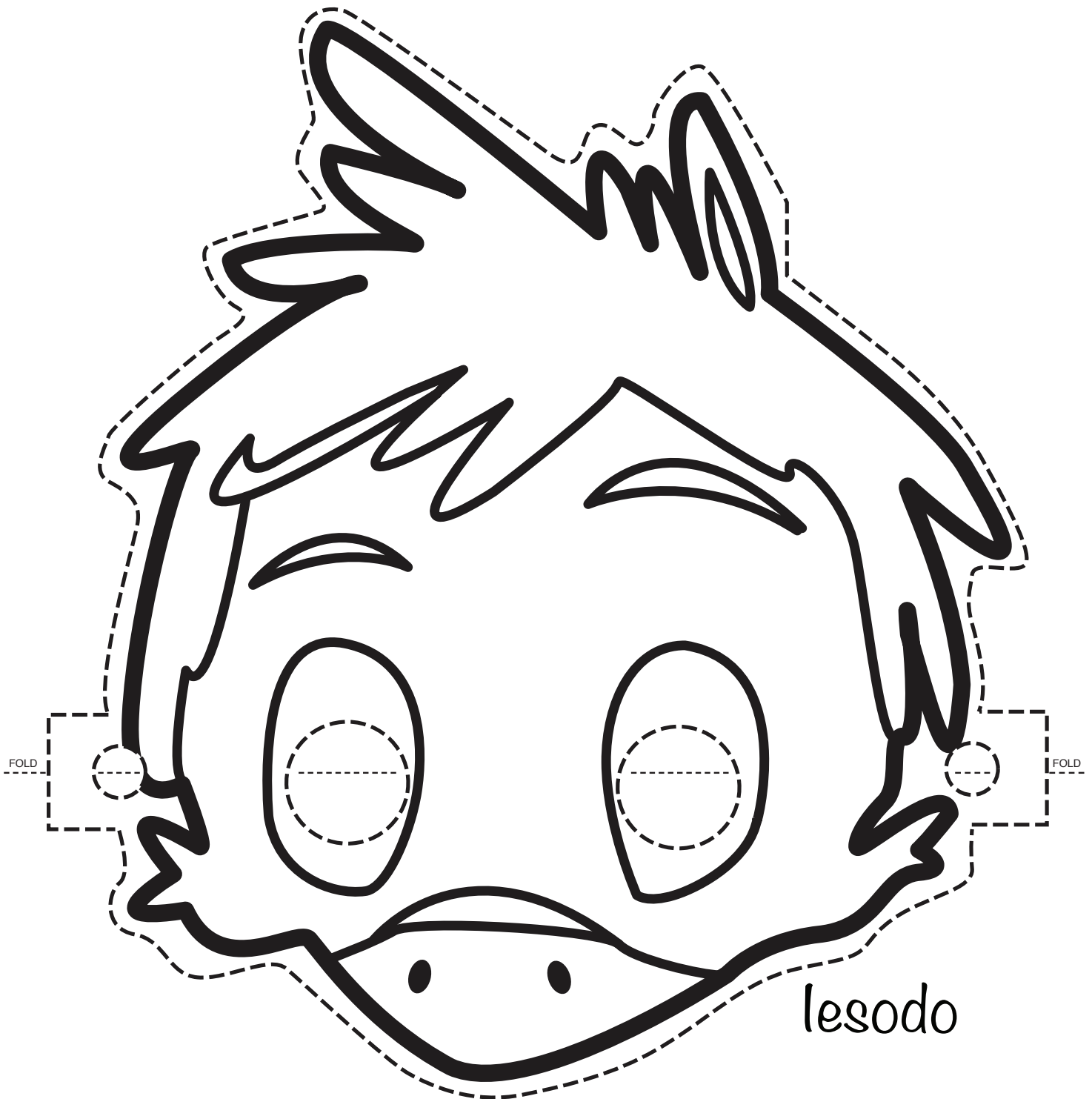
Color • Decorate • Cut • Tape • Tie

Parents:

- Print out on card stock
- Crease masks along the horizontal fold lines indicated
- Using adult scissors, cut out the circles for eyes

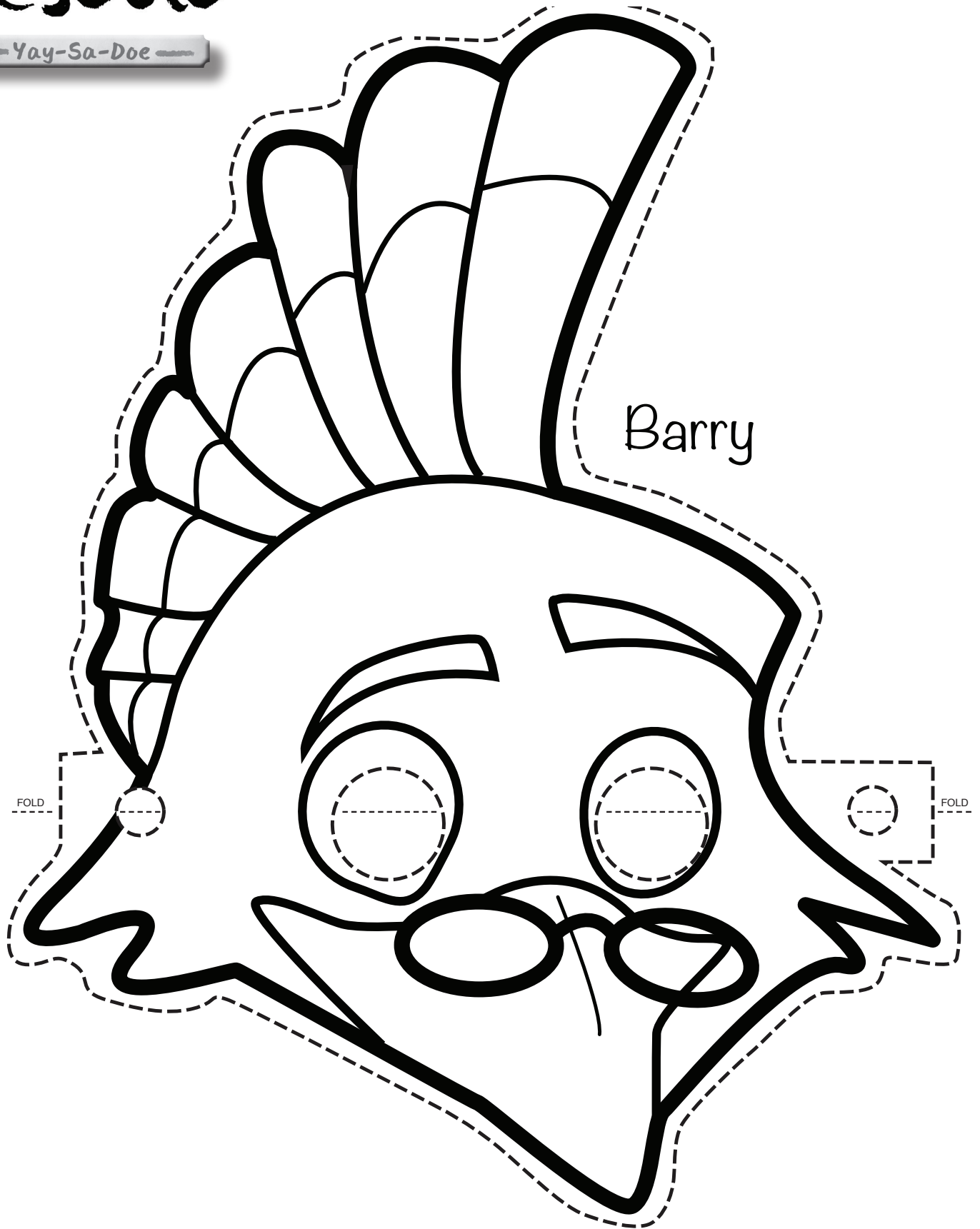
Children:

- Color the masks
- Using school glue, feathers, glitter, etc., decorate your mask (optional)
- Under adult supervision, use child-safe scissors to cut along the dotted line around the face
- Put a piece of transparent tape over the circles on either side of the face
- Using a hole punch, create a hole on either side of the face
- Tie one piece (about one foot long) of string to each hole
- Ask a parent to tie strings together to put the mask on your face
