

## LET'S TALK ABOUT IT

**Jesus was a new teacher who became very popular because of what He said and did. He was different! He loved everyone and paid special attention to the poor, the needy, and those who were not liked by others. He saw something special and valuable in everyone!**

This “Sermon on the Mount,” we call it, was a very important time for Jesus to share with everyone His message. There was lots of excitement to hear what this new teacher was going to say. Everyone was eager to hear Jesus explain how His teachings were different from what they had been taught before.

**Jesus's teachings are called “The Beattitudes,” they are the way Jesus shows us what our “attitude” should “be!”**

**#1 If you are humble, then your heart is right.** What does it mean to be humble?

**#4 If you hunger and thirst, things will get better.** What does it mean to hunger and thirst for something? Jesus wants us to hunger and thirst to be like Him—to talk, walk, love, and think like Jesus. What is one way you can do this?

**#5 "If you try to make peace, you will be the happy one."** What does lesodo (who represents Jesus) mean, when He says, "Make peace"? Can you remember, when you had a choice to make peace with others or to cause trouble? When you can make peace and show love to someone, does that make you happy?

**Just like lesodo wanted the other birds to learn a new lesson, Jesus wants us to learn to have a new attitude. If we do, we have the chance to change the world—and you will be the happy one!**

In this episode we meet a little finch named Luke. Luke was blind and was on a search to meet lesodo. He felt lesodo could somehow help him fly. 
